1. What cookies are

Cookies are small text files a website stores on your device. Similar technologies (pixels, local storage, embedded third-party scripts) work in comparable ways. Cookies can be “first-party” (set by egraine.fi) or “third-party” (set by another provider), and either “session” (deleted when you close your browser) or “persistent” (kept for a set period).

2. Our approach

This website currently sets no cookies at all. We do not use analytics, advertising or tracking cookies, we do not build visitor profiles, and no third-party service is loaded when you view our pages — the site’s fonts and all other assets are served from our own hosting.

Because the site sets no cookies and makes no pre-consent third-party calls, **no cookie-consent banner is required** under the ePrivacy rules as implemented in Finland (Act on Electronic Communications Services, 917/2014) and Traficom’s cookie guidance — this notice is provided for transparency.

If we ever introduce cookies, any that are strictly necessary for the site to function will be listed here, and any non-essential cookies (for example analytics) will be set **only after you give consent** through a cookie banner, with an equally easy option to reject, and you will be able to change or withdraw your choice at any time. We will not rely on pre-ticked boxes, “legitimate interest”, or your browser settings as a substitute for consent.

3. Managing your choices

You can delete or block cookies in your browser settings at any time. Because this site sets no cookies, doing so will not affect how it works for you.

4. International transfers

No third-party services load on our pages, so viewing this website transfers no personal data outside our own hosting. How we handle personal data more generally — including any transfers by our service providers — is described in our [Privacy Policy](#).

5. Changes to this policy

We may update this policy if the cookies or technologies we use change. The current version, with its “last updated” date, will always be available on this website.
